#### Harvest

Rainham Foodbank opened in 2011 and has been serving our community ever since. We are able to issue foodbank vouchers - please remember this as the cost of living crisis continues to bite. 1 in 5 children live below the poverty line - six children per class on average... A typical parcel contains;

- Breakfast cereals
- Soup
- Pasta (not currently needed)
- Rice
- Pasta sauce
- Tinned beans
- Tinned meat/fish
- Tinned vegetables
- Tinned fruit
- Tea or coffee
- Sugar
- Biscuits
- Snacks

In 2020-2021 they gave out 4456 parcels.

Our Harvest celebration will take place in the K52 hall on Friday 7th October. All proceeds will go to Rainham Foodbank. In exchange for non-uniform, we will ask children to bring in a food/toiletry donation.

They currently urgently need these items in particular: Long life milk, jam, toothpaste, shower gel, shampoo and sanitary towels.
