#### HAF

We hope to be able to offer a HAF programme during the Summer holiday period. Each eligible child would be entitled to 64 hours. Children do not need to sign up for all sessions and you can pick and choose to fit in with your family commitments. As well as multi sport activities, children will receive a hot meal daily. #### Coronation

To comply with Natasha's Law, the sandwiches will be made in school and will contain strawberry jam (Ingredients: Sugar, strawberry puree, citric acid, gelling agent pectin, acidity regulator), honey, white bread and buttery spread (Ingredients: water, rapeseed oil, palm oil, palm kernel oil, reconstituted buttermilk, salt, emulsifier, preservatives, acidity regulator, vitamin E, Colour, flavouring, vitamin A, Vitamin D.).

We have planned for this to take place indoors as the weather recently has been so unpredictable.
