School Meal Holiday Scheme

School pupils in Havering are being offered meal support during the February half-term Applications for the School Meal break. Holiday Scheme are open and will allow eligible families to apply for £15 per child to buy food to replace the meals their child would have received at school. The scheme is run by Havering Council and is part of the government's Household Support Fund. Families that have previously received money for their child or children from the scheme and are still eligible, do not need to apply again, and will automatically receive the money into their chosen account. However, parents and carers should check the claims criteria on the Council's website as they may now be eligible to make a claim or are able to claim for an additional child. Havering Council has launched a new public consultation to hear residents' views on leading a healthier lifestyle. Research shows that Havering has high rates of childhood and adulthood obesity, with approximately one in five reception aged children, two in five year 6-aged children and 65% of adults being overweight or obese, making the borough one of the most overweight in London. Where we live, work and play has a huge impact on what we eat, how much we eat and how much exercise we get during the day. If surrounded by unhealthy options, it makes it more difficult to have a healthy lifestyle. The new consultation opened this week and will run until Sunday 3 March. 
